Our July meeting attracted about 30 attendees including 4 competitors in the annual Jimmy Durham memorial competition for junior players. President Donald Galloway opened the evening and introduced Vice President Andrew Roach as the judge for the evening. The competitors then played off in the following order:

While the judge was deliberating Callum Pert played for us *Leaving Lismore* and *Kilworth Hills*.

Last years winner, Mitchell Durham (a grandson of Jimmy Durham after whom the trophy is named, was present and before the presentation of prizes he played for us a set of tunes including *John MacDonald of Glencoe*, *79th's Farewell to Gibraltar*, *Flower of Scotland*, *Wings* and *Lord Lovat's Lament*.

By now it was time to announce the results and present the prizes as follows:

Mitchell Durham formally passed on the trophy to Ben Morris.

The piping was not over of course. Ben Morris gave us a selection including *Loch of the Birds*, *Thief of Lochaber*, *Piper's Bonnet*, *The Rejected Suitor*, *The Tower of London* and *Dr P H Iles*. He was followed by Jordan Simmers with *The Saffron Kilt*, *Cork Hill* and *Pibroch o' Donald Dhu*.

Finally Andrew Roach played for us. Before doing so, he commented that the competitors had played in a much more relaxed manner when they played for the second time without the competition pressure. He said that they need to aim for playing that way and showing confidence when they are competing. He also commented that playing accurately on the beat is very important, especially in a 2/4 March. His tunes included *Jim McWilliams*, *Bob of Fettercairn*,

After playing he gave a bit of a word picture of "Worlds Week" in Glasgow as he was due to fly out the next week to play with Inverary and District in the Worlds. He went through many of the activities that take place in the week before the Championships and during the Championships itself.

Nick Tomkins then spoke to us about St Andrews Pipe Band's fund raiser for their trip to Scotland next year on the night of the Worlds, featuring live streaming of the event and other entertainment at a top venue and

encouraged as many people as possible to come along.

Finally the raffle was drawn, with Hazel Osborne doing the drawing and Nick Tomkins doing the winning. He was seen to remark afterwards on Facebook that he was glad Lachlan McPhee was in Scotland and unable to win the whisky this time!

Donald closed the meeting with encouragement to all to come along next month and we all proceeded to supper and much conversation.
